Sport and physical activity will be used as a safe, accessible gateway to engage women and girls who may be affected by domestic abuse, social isolation, poor mental wellbeing, or barriers to accessing traditional support services. These sessions will provide consistent, trusted spaces where women can build relationships, improve confidence, and feel comfortable returning week after week.	£5,620.00
Lead: Mad Theatre Company Partners: Enterprising Youth, One Step, Happy Me Community	Domestic Abuse Project	Boroughwide	The project will comprise of 20 sessions, 2 hours per week over 20 weeks delivering preventative work to approximately 20 vulnerable young people, teaching them how to spot the signs of a potential abusive relationship, explore toxic masculinity etc. with the aim to empower the young people to make positive choices. This project will use drama as a tool to explore issues through improvisation to untap creativity and explore the wide ranging impacts of abuse.	£10,050.00
